

## 2024 Trade Associations and Policy Groups

PepsiCo discloses contributions to trade associations and policy groups of which PepsiCo is a member.<sup>1</sup> For organizations outside the United States, contribution amounts typically reflect annual membership dues. For organizations in the U.S., contribution ranges reflect total giving, which may include annual membership dues as well as additional sponsorships for events and programs. For U.S. organizations that receive more than \$100,000 in contributions, PepsiCo has provided the percentage of the amount that is used for lobbying and therefore not deductible for business expenses. Trade associations are subject to PepsiCo's Third Party Due Diligence program, as described in our [Global Anti-Bribery Compliance Policy](#).
